

## Activity Sheet 1.3: Expense Cheat Sheet

Below are some average costs for living expenses in Quebec. These will fluctuate based on where you live.

### **Average Monthly costs**

One-bedroom rental: \$600-\$800

Two-bedroom rental: \$800-\$1,600

Groceries: \$200-\$250 per person

Household communications (phone, cable and Internet): \$200-\$250

Car costs (maintenance, gas, insurance): \$450

Utilities (gas/heating, electricity): \$175

Daycare: \$170-\$400

### **Other Costs**

Wedding: \$300 (Civil)— \$20,000 (reception)

Condo/House: \$200,000-\$400,000 (Canadian average: \$250,000)

University: \$3,330 per year

CEGEP: \$800 per year (for 2 sessions including books and materials)
